

2010 Cross Compliance Inspection Statistics

The tables below provide a breakdown of the non-compliances (breaches) found during the cross compliance related inspections carried out during the 2010 calendar year.

The Individual Table shows the number and level of separate breaches found under each Statutory Management Requirement (SMR) and Good Agricultural and Environmental Condition (GAEC). The Overall Table shows the number and level of reductions applied to farmers' claims once the various capping and repetition rules have been applied.

These reductions have been applied to 2010 Single Farm Payment Scheme (SFPS), Less Favoured Area Support Scheme (LFASS), Scottish Beef Calf Scheme (SBCS) and certain Rural Priorities (RP) and Land Manager's Options (LMO) scheme payments.

The current total value of cross compliance reductions applied in 2010 is £605,173*.

The current total value of payments made under the above schemes in 2010 is £591,365,755*.

During 2010 a total of 1801 cross compliance related inspections were completed.
